

Post Mastectomy Care



All individuals receiving post mastectomy care have the following rights:

- To select those who provide quality post mastectomy care.
- To be treated by Certified Fitters trained and licensed in post mastectomy care.
- To receive the appropriate, medically prescribed care in a professional manner without discrimination relative to your age, sex, race, religion, ethnic origin, sexual preference, physical or mental condition.
- To be treated in a manner that is sensitive to social and cultural diversity and in accordance with the law.
- To be treated with friendliness, courtesy and respect.
- To participate in your post mastectomy care.
- To receive adequate information that allows for informed consent for all aspects of treatment.
- To comment on care without fear of discrimination or reprisal.
- To receive reasonable information relative to all aspects of treatment including alternatives and risks.
- To receive post mastectomy care in a timely manner in accordance with your health plan.
- To refuse treatment and receive professional information of any consequences.
- To have a reasonable expectation of privacy.
- To have reasonable access to medical records.
